- Bluetooth Adapter and Cell Phone USB Cable.
- Download "CaddyTrek R3" APP.

Set up Bluetooth pairing with R3

- 1. Insert the Bluetooth Adapter into the USB port on the back of R3.
- 2. Turn on R3.
- 3. Open "CaddyTrek R3" APP on your phone.
- 4. Click "Search CaddyTrek".
- 5. Select R3 product number and enter operational page.

Operation Modes

Click "Follow" or "Push" to engage operation mode. Click again to disengage and back to Operational Page.

Setting Page

- Name: Name your R3 with seven-digit alphanumeric characters (capital letters and numbers).
- Camera Calibration: The following distance between you and R3 is abnormal. Please contact FTR Systems to calibrate camera.
- Gyroscope Calibration: Click to calibrate gyroscope. Reboot R3 after calibration completed.
